BROAD VIEW

Bore-out, the new psychosocial risk? When boredom at work becomes painful

A bore-out is a consequence of the chronic mismatch between «duration of a working day» and «low volume of activity» and seems to be as frequently encountered as burnouts. The principles for prevention of bore-outs are addressed.

Predictive factors for a declaration of unfitness or fitness with restrictions for a previous workstation at the return-to-work medical examination: development of a rating system
