TO KEEP IN MIND

Severe silicosis linked to the use of reconstituted stones

During production, dry cutting or installation, workers may be exposed to these materials, which are mainly used in interior decoration.

Publication of two reports from ANSES (French Agency for Food, Environmental and Occupational Health & Safety).

These two collaborative expert reviews are titled Assessment of health risks related to night work and Occupational exposure to pesticides in agriculture.

Decree No. 2016-756 of 7 June 2016 relating to improvements to how psychological disorders are recognised as occupational diseases and to how the CRRMP (regional committees for the recognition of occupational diseases) function

This text modifies the Social Insurance code and sets out the methods that should be applied when examining cases, in particular in relation to psychological disorders.
