TO KEEP IN MIND

Keeping up with occupational safety and health news: the «regional documentary bulletin» Presentation of the network of documentalists of the Pays de la Loire region and their «regional documentary bulletin».

Assessment of risks caused by climate change to workers' health. Collective ANSES (French Agency for Food, Environmental and Occupational Health & Safety) expertise

This risk assessment, performed considering the circumstances of exposure, gives an overall view of changes to come, across different professions.

National strategy for endocrine disruptors. Evaluation of the implementation and proposals for development

In December 2017, IGAS (social affairs inspectorate) evaluated this strategy, and found it to be relevant and appropriate but with room for improvement. It proposes five prospects for future development.

Cardiology essentials for occupational physicians. Jean Bertran seminar

The topics addressed included the fate of patients with cardiovascular diseases, the role of occupational physicians in treatment, the cardiovascular impact of night work, etc.

Exposure to biological pathogens and technical prevention measures

The order of 27 December 2017 amends the classification of biological agents and the technical prevention measures in laboratories.

The list of biological pathogens presented here includes all of the amendments and additions made to the order of 18 July 1994 by the order of 27 December 2017.

BROAD VIEW

Mapping of exposure to polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons (PAHs) by sector of activity: focus on the biological surveillance of occupational exposure

Biometrological data on occupational exposure to PAHs by sector of activity are used to prioritise the implementation of prevention measures based on the tasks or workstations at risk.

FIELD VIEW

Risk of exposure to blood during venous blood sampling in private medical biology laboratories in

This survey shows that the risk of exposure to blood is two times lower, and the use of secure material two times higher than during a survey in 2005 carried out under the same conditions.

Occupational exposure of hospital healthcare personnel to cytotoxic drugs. Biometrology and measurement of surface contamination

A study conducted in 12 hospitals showed that exposure, mainly by dermal route, affected all professional categories, from pharmacy technicians to couriers.

Contribution of nurses to promoting the occupational health of workers exposed to noise in a saw-mill

This article presents the value of nurses during an assessment of risks and promotion of occupational health, with the implementation of collective and personal preventive measures.

The bibliographical database LiSSa (Littérature scientifique en santé (scientific health literature)): value and use in occupational health

This bibliographical database of scientific literature in the French language contains over one million references. It is multidisciplinary and its results can be exported.

Prevention of occupational risks in the traditional catering industry: a national action programme to be perpetuated in micro-enterprises

This programme by Social security, the traditional catering industry association and the network of chambers of commerce and industry, seeks to promote the assessment and prevention of occupational risks.

Personal care and assistance. INRS Technical day. Paris, 9 November 2017

This day highlighted the need to include prevention in the design stage of technical assistance aids for the care activity, as well as the value of initial and continuous training of healthcare personnel.

26th annual day of the Study group on the risk of exposure for healthcare workers (GERES). Paris, 24 November 2017

This day presented a review of vaccine protection, surveillance of infectious risk and recommendations about post-exposure treatment in healthcare personnel.
